## *Rules and Conditions – Field Farm Fisheries*

THESE RULES ENSURE THAT THE FISHERIES IS A PLEASANT PLACE TO BE FOR ALL OUR MEMBERS

- Bring your membership card each time you fish.
- Pay for your fishing as soon as you arrive. We will be checking that tickets have been purchased.
- Dip all nets when entering the fishery (using the dip net tanks provided)
- The use of radios and bad language is forbidden
- Alcohol is strictly banned at the fishery
- No dogs are allowed
- Strictly no night fishing
- Please take all litter home with you. We don't have bins as they encourage vermin.
- Keepnets, sacks and tubes are not permitted. All fish are to be returned to the water immediately. If taking photos this must be done over an unhooking mat kneeling down.
- Fish may not be taken home under any circumstances. This would result in immediate banning and police prosecution.
- Use only barbless hooks.
- All forms of fixed lead and leadcore are banned. Only free running leads to be used.
- Do not fish for carp unless you are in possession of a large landing net and a large padded unhooking mat. Weigh all fish over this unhooking mat and don't stand up when returning the fish to water. A dropped fish is a dead fish!
- Particle baits and bloodworm are banned – with the exception of sweetcorn and carp pellet.
- Do not throw away any unused bait or groundbait
- Please don't leave any discarded line.
- The Fishery owner reserves the right to ban any member who does not follow the rules.
- The Fishery opens one hour after daylight and one hour before dusk.
